Type of material: Wood care

Range of uses: Jansen Larch wood oil is suitable for dry and stable substrates. The

moisture content of the wood must not exceed 18%. Ideal for exterior softwood and pressure impregnated timber such as floors, terraces,

partitioning walls and garden furniture.

Product properties: Wood oil - matt, slightly thixotropic, transparent, containing solvents.

Prevents weathering and cracking of wood. Strongly water repellent,

spreads well, pleasant to work with.

Method of processing

Substrate preparation: The substrate must be bound, firm, stable, dry, clean and free of

separating substances.

New wood – prime with Jansen Wood Primer WV

New pressure impregnated timber – paint with Jansen Larch wood oil

directly.

Sound existing paint – thoroughly clean the surface, lightly sand if

necessary.

<u>Weathered</u>, <u>grey timber</u> – sand down to healthy, raw wood. Completely remove loose, flaking and brittle coatings.

The preparation of substrates and the coating itself should be state-of-the-art. Please in this respect also note ÖNORM B 2230 as amended.

Apply a trial coating before actual application.

If several containers are used to apply the final coat, ensure batch

uniformity.

Coating structure: Jansen Larch wood oil is a deep penetration wood care oil.

New coatings: Brush twice with Jansen Larch wood oil.

Renovation coating: Brush once or twice with Jansen Larch wood oil. In the case of heavily weathered wood terracing, we would recommend

coating with a pigmented Jansen impregnating varnish.

Methods of application: Brushing

Clean with white spirit or Jansen Nitro cleaner immediately after use.

Storage: Dry and frost-protected. Sealed, at least 24 months shelf life.

Reseal opened containers well and briefly turn upside-down.
